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## Candy Party

You are having a party and want to buy some candy to feed your guests! At the store, they only sell candy in packages. You cannot buy a single piece of candy.

The Constraints - How do decide what to buy:

- You estimate you will need at least 58 pieces of candy for your party.
- Some people are allergic to chocolate so you need at least 1 kind of candy that has no chocolate at your party.
- You can buy no more than 4 different kinds of candy to have at your party.

The Candy comes in packages like this:

* 2 Fireballs (no chocolate)
* 2 pieces of bubble gum (no chocolate)
* 5 Kit-Kats
* 5 Airheads (no chocolate)
* 10 mini Reeses Peanut Butter Cups
* 10 Hershey’s Kisses

The Constraints:

Challenge: You only have $\$ 10.00$ so you can spend no more than $\$ 10.00$.

The candy comes in packages like this:

* 2 Fireballs - $\$ 0.50$ (no chocolate)
* 2 pieces of bubble gum - $\mathbf{\$ 0 . 1 0 ~ ( n o ~ c h o c o l a t e ) ~}$
* 5 Kit-Kats - $\$ 1.50$
* 5 Airheads - $\$ 0.50$ (no chocolate)
* 10 mini Reeses Peanut Butter Cups - $\$ 1.00$
* $\mathbf{1 0}$ Hershey's Kisses - \$0.50
